COVID-19 Response Fund:

The Imperial Valley Wellness Foundation, in partnership with Alliance Healthcare Foundation and other generous donors launched a COVID-19 Response Fund in April 2020 for nonprofit organizations that serve Imperial County. As of December 2020, more than \$850,000 had been raised and more than \$560,000 had been distributed with another funding round to begin in January 2021. When the funding round opens, nonprofit organizations are able to apply for a one-time grant ranging from \$1,000 - \$50,000.
